HOW AND WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

3.1 We may collect and process the following personal information about you.

4.4 Where it is in your **VITAL INTEREST**

4.5 Where required to comply with our Legal Obligations

4.6 Where there is **LEGITIMATE INTEREST**

To comply with a request from you in connection with the exercise of your rights

To enforce or protect our contractual or other legal rights or to bring or defend legal proceedings:

For general administration including managing your queries, complaints, or claims and to send service messages to you.

5 Other ways we may share your personal information

We may transfer your personal information to a third party as part of a sale. We may also transfer your personal information if we're under a duty to disclose or share in order to comply with any legal obligation (e.g. by sharing your personal information with the DVLA) However, we will always take steps with the aim of ensuring that your privacy rights continue to be protected.

6 How Long we keep your personal information for.

- 6.1 If we collect your personal information, the length of time we retain it is determined by a number of factors including the purpose for which we use that information and our obligations under other laws.
- 6.2 We do not retain personal information in an identifiable format for longer than is necessary.

7 Your rights.

7.1 Your data subject rights

You have a number of rights in relation to your personal information under data protection law. Except in rare cases, we will respond to you within 30 days after we have received this information or, where no such information is required, after we have received your request.

8 Accessing your personal information

8.1 Erasing your personal information or restricting its processing.

Unless there is a reason that the law allows us to use your personal information for longer, we will make reasonable efforts to comply with your request.

8.2 Complaining to the UK data protection regulator.

8.3. Withdrawing your consent

Use of Cookies

Cookies are small pieces of information sent to your device and stored on its hard drive to allow our website to recognise you when you visit.

We are simply advised that the transaction has been successful.

9.1 Social plugins.

We use so-called social plugins (buttons) of social networks such as Facebook, when you visit our website, this button is deactivated by default, i.e. without your intervention they will not send any data to the respective social network. Before you are able to use the button, you must activate it by clicking on it. It then remains active until you deactivate it or delete your cookies.
